



Hello, Learning Path visitors:

We have a new experience planned for you!

The home page for the Learning Path site will be updated in mid-June, to a new format that aligns with Microsoft's branding and with our Partner University portal. This will be a dramatic change, so we're giving you a preview now (please read on), and we invite your feedback and questions about this change.

Our goal, in updating this site, is to give you what you've been asking for. We know that the existing Learning Path site is not responsive. We know that it's tough to find the newest courses and that the Search feature isn't robust. We intend to change all of that. With the new user interface, we plan to deliver:

- Filters that allow you to search for the courses you want by Role, Product, Solution and Competency
- New Search capability that offers you better precision
- A gallery view of the newest courses, updated monthly
- Solutions pages that showcase training related to a priority area of focus
- A special section for MPN Global Administrators

Please note: this new interface will be attached to the "old" Learning Paths site. This means the courses and Learning Paths you've bookmarked or you use frequently will not go away. We are simply integrating a new "store front" to the site, one that will give you an improved search experience.

We plan to launch this new home page in mid-June.


See below for screenshots that illustrate how the new user interface will look. At the end of this update, you'll find guidance for sharing feedback with us.

## Here's what the new home page will look like.

At the top, you'll see there are filters allowing you to search for training by Role, Solution, Products, Competency, New releases (newest content), and a special spot for those who manage teams and assign courses.

The image banner at the top of the page will allow us to bring training campaigns to your attention, such as news about the latest set of Azure Skills offerings.

The purple bar will give you one-click access to [Microsoft's Events page](#), which is tough to find today on the MPN portal.


## One of the new filters at the top of the page will be Solutions.

The "Cert" button refers to certification resources.

The banner displaying Yammer resources will lead you to relevant Yammer Study Groups.
